ERAU professor presents 'Bike there!'

Dr. Jason Aufdenberg will share information about cargo bikes, route planning, and the building of a better bicycle infrastructure at 2 p.m. Saturday, March 5, in the Launch Pad at the Daytona Beach Regional Library at City Island, 105 E. Magnolia Ave., Daytona Beach

After his presentation, he'll demonstrate how to fix a flat tire.

Dr. Aufdenberg is an associate professor of physics and astronomy at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University and a member of the River to Sea TPO's Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee. His observations are based on almost a decade of using the bicycle as a primary mode of transportation in the Daytona Beach area.
