

Downtown Daytona to get a Hamburger Mary's

DAYTONA BEACH

A Hamburger Mary's Bar & Grille restaurant is coming to downtown Daytona Beach.

Selby Realty Inc. announced that it has leased an 8,089-squarefoot storefront space at 180 N. Beach St., just south of Bay Street, to a company called Hamburger Mary's Daytona LLC, which plans to open a franchise Hamburger Mary's eatery.

Hamburger Mary's International, according to its website, is a "franchise system" of open-air bar-and-grill restaurants that operate under the name Hamburger Mary's in multiple states across the country including a location in downtown Orlando. The first Hamburger Mary's opened in San Francisco in 1972. Hamburger Mary's International is now co-headquartered in West Hollywood, California, and Chicago, Illinois. It bills its eateries as "open-air bar and grilles for open-minded people."

The storefront space has been the address of a number of eateries over the years including Cafe Del Mar and Arena Spaces Cafe. The landlord is Burgoyne Properties Ltd.
