

## **Halifax Historical Museum presents Wild Life Photographer Paul Rebmann**

The Halifax Historical Museum is pleased to present *Discovering Nature: Past and Present*, a talk by wild life photographer Paul Rebmann and a collection of his photographs of plants and animals endemic to Volusia County. The program will be held on two dates, Thursday, October 22 at 5:30 p.m. and again on Saturday, October 31 at 10 a.m.

Rebmann's narrated visual presentation also explores the distinctly diverse 300-year history of Florida's animal and plant species, many of which were discovered and named after early botanical explorers like Ferdinand Rugel (1806-1879). Rugel discovered a little plant near New Smyrna in 1848 that was named Rugel's pawpaw. The only place in the world that Rugel's pawpaw has been found is Volusia County, Florida.

The Paul Rebmann photography exhibit, *Our Natural World Around Us* is on display at the Halifax Historical Museum, 252 South Beach Street, Downtown Daytona through November 14.

Museum hours are Tuesday through Friday, 10:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. and Saturdays from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. Admission to the museum is \$5 for adults and \$1 for children 12 and younger. On Thursdays, admission to the museum is by free-will donation. Ample, free parking is located behind the museum east of Palmetto Avenue between Magnolia and Orange avenues.
