The line up of the premiere showcase includes:

MIKE DORN

Mike has released 6 albums and is ranked nationally in Folk, in top 30 for 2 years, and was #1 in Detroit folk, and now #1 overall artist in Daytona Beach, by Reverbnation. He has performed mostly around his home town of Detroit, MI since the early 90’s, solo and with a few bands, most notably: Duck Tape Mummies and Big Green X. He was the winner of the Detroit Music Awards 1999, performed and won the Lollapalooza Grand Champion Poetry Slam, and toured as a member of Detroit Poetry Slam Team. Recently voted 2nd top acoustic act nationally In The Warped Tour Battle of the Bands 2012.

BRUCE MCDERMOTT

Plays everything from blues, ballads, country and some folk. He has mostly performed in and around Connecticut and Rhode Island and now Daytona Beach.

ROGER DUVERNOY

Guitar, harmonica, base and keyboard. He hails from New York, where he has performed in various venues in Rockland County. Winner of 2 prestigious MacDowell Poetry Fellowships, and is a member of *Poets and Writers*. Roger was a founding member of the punk/rock/blues band *The Frankenwankers*. He has recorded numerous songs, and has also performed spoken word in the Daytona Beach area as *Arthritic Gangsta*.

BRADLEY GRIESE

Bradley is a singer/songwriter who also hosts open mics around the Daytona Beach area. He plays folk, rock and blues, and originally hails from New York .
