DAYTONA BEACH- Cinematique Under The Stars – the free monthly outdoor film series presented by the local independent Art House Cinema – The Cinematique Theater - announces the schedule for 2014.

Cinematique Under The Stars – a perfect outdoor movie experience. Enjoy the fresh air, river breeze and beauty of historic downtown Daytona Beach. Movies will be shown on the 4<sup>th</sup> Friday of each month in River Front Park, the corner of Beach and Magnolia Streets in downtown Daytona Beach. Showtime is dusk, ranging from 6pm in the winter to 9pm in the summer. Patrons must bring a chair or blanket to sit in the grass, no coolers please! Concession items are available for purchase. “The outdoor films are for our community” said Stephanie Mason-Teague, Executive Director of Cinematique of Daytona, Inc. “River Front Park is centrally located near our year round cinema with plenty of free parking and many shops and restaurants”.

All of the films in the series are based on books. City Island Library, with support from the Friends of the Library, is hosting a monthly Book Club to encourage literacy and discussion of both the movie and the book. The Book club will meet at the Cinematique Theater the following day, Saturday, at 10:00 am. Admission to the book club is also free, and many of the books are available to check out from the library. Deborah Shafer, organizer of the book club and librarian at City Island Library, said “The book and movie club will make a great night out, a perfect way to spend time with friends and meet new ones”.

The monthly film series is part of Front Porch Fridays; an initiative of The River Front Shops of Daytona Beach to showcase the many unique offerings in historic downtown on the FOURTH Friday of each month. Attendees are encouraged to visit the many restaurants and shops that line Beach Street. As well as the art, food and music vendors that will be set up in the park.
