ERAU professor presents 'Bike there!'

Dr. Jason Aufdenberg will share information about cargo bikes, route planning, and the building of a better bicycle infrastructure at 2 p.m. Saturday, April 29, in the Launch Pad at the Daytona Beach Regional Library at City Island, 105 E. Magnolia Ave.

His observations are based on almost a decade of using the bicycle as a primary mode of transportation in the Daytona Beach area.

Dr. Aufdenberg is an associate professor of physics and astronomy at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University and a member of the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization's Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee. The TPO is an independent group of local governments and citizens who voice concerns, identify priorities, and plan for transportation improvements for projects funded with state and federal transportation dollars in Volusia County and areas of Flagler County.
