

Beach Street Shamrock Jam Street Party



A dance exhibition by a group from Hendricks School of Irish Dance will kick off McK's Tavern Street Party at 4 p.m. Thursday, March 17, in downtown Daytona Beach. Banished Misfortune, a traditional Irish band, will supply live music throughout the evening, breaking only for dance group performances at 6 and 8 p.m.

McK's will have a full bar set up outside, including a stock of Guinness and Guinness Blonde beers, and will serve corn beef and cabbage. The restaurant will be open for seating and full service inside as well, but owner Scott Lawson expects a big crowd, so finding an open table may prove difficult. Reservations for a table during party hours will not be accepted.

The street area will offer much more space, Lawson said, with "places for people to sit, relax and enjoy the music."

The atmosphere is geared toward adults, but shouldn't get too rowdy, he said. "Nothing crazy will be going on out there, just music and drinking — and there'll be plenty of drinking."

S. Beach Street will close from Orange Avenue to Magnolia Avenue around 3 p.m. and reopen at 11:30 p.m.

McK's Tavern Street Party, 218 S. Beach St., Daytona Beach, will run from 4 p.m. to midnight.
